AWARDS

Prize money to 3rd place for each event – Groups S,A,B,C,D,E
NOTE: Where there are less than four competitors in a group only first place prize money will be awarded for that group

Ribbons to 6th place in each event – Groups F, G and H
Trophies to 3rd for overall placings in groups F, G and H

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. Each competitor must be a member of a pony club affiliated with PCAQ **OR** sign a PCAQ indemnity form prior to competing.
2. All events to be conducted and judged in accordance with PCAQ Rules for Sporting and Campdraft
3. The host club reserves the right to make changes to the program as circumstances dictate.
4. The organising committee, Withcott Pony Club Inc and PCAQ do not accept liability for any accident, injury or illness sustained by horses, owners, riders, spectators, grounds or any other person or property whatsoever.
5. Competitors leaving their group without permission of the steward will be disqualified from competition.
6. Competitors riding in a dangerous manner will be disqualified from competition
7. The judges decision is final. Any disputes must be lodged in writing, to the Withcott Pony Club secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence. A fee of \$33 is to accompany the lodgment of the dispute.
8. One Horse, one rider. A competitor may nominate twice with two different horses (second horse must be ready to be ridden when required by the judge).
9. All clothing and equipment is to comply with PCAQ regulations (Uniform and Saddlery Rules for gear check). Gear check will be conducted prior to the start of competition.
10. No alcohol is to be consumed on the grounds during the competition.
11. Each horse/rider combination is only eligible for one placing in each event (ie. You can't win 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the same event by re-running)
